SOMERSET SAM was urged to secure a forward placing along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out approaching the turn to race outside the pacesetter, drew on terms with that foe in upper stretch, then took over and went clear under firm right handed encouragement. EMAIL ALERT, bumped at the start, was righted to track the pace racing four wide in the second flight early, then made steady progress outside foes to secure second in the drive while no threat to the winner. JAYEMBRO broke out, bumped EARLY OUT EDDIE, was righted to track the pace between foes and steadily improved his position to the final stages. MAN UP sped readily to the lead while angling sharply to the inside, held sway to upper stretch but emptied out once headed by the winner leaving the furlong marker. CHI BUT PROUD was allowed to settle along the inside, saved ground to upper stretch, then passed inside tiring rivals to gain some position late. CHASE ME was caught five deep racing to the turn, continued widest on the bend while making a brief bid, but flattened out in upper stretch. VALIANT AFFAIR raced unhurried along the inside in the opening stages, was caught in tight quarters entering the bend and forced to steady, continued along the inside while making a brief bid but had no final response. I GOTTA HEMI was a brief factor between foes but faded steadily nearing upper stretch. SPEED LIMIT GHAZI broke in, bumped EMAIL ALERT, was righted to track outside foes racing to the bend but offered no rally. DIXIE GOURMET flashed brief pace near the inside but dropped out early. EARLY OUT EDDIE, bumped at the start, soon dropped out.
